**Closing date for national qualifiers is 21 days prior to the event, please make sure that you pay via the British Riding clubs payment page for pre entry to Stoneleigh, go to BRC payments. Closing date to area is 21 days, late entries will be accepted but there will be an additional £10.00 per entry.**

### **Local Entries.**

Entries for the above competitions can be on a local level, which means the competitor only pays the fee to Area 2 and not to nationally. They are awarded points which are added up at the end of the Summer season. Entries for this still require them to be in **21 days prior to the event.**

### **Team Managers.**

It is recommended that each club provides a team manager who is able to remain with their team throughout the day, this is partly due for health and safety reasons, in the event of an accident, so someone can take responsibility for that person, horse, etc. It also allows your team members to be introduced to each other and feel part of the team that is representing their club.

### **COMPETITORS CONDUCT AT COMPETITIONS**

As a competitor you need to be aware of your responsibilities.

- Be courteous to all stewards and helpers, they like you are Riding Club members who have given up their time so you can compete.
- It is your responsibility to know the rules of the competition, riding club rules do vary from other disciplines, all rules can be viewed on the British Riding Club website. [www.britishridingclubs.co.uk](http://www.britishridingclubs.co.uk) and also the rule book can be downloaded from this site.
- The owners of each venue have spent time preparing the premises for us to use, so please respect any of their wishes regarding the use of the venue.
- You are responsible for making sure that your vaccinations for your horse/pony are up to date.
- Anyone who is verbally abusive to any other rider, steward or helper, will be asked to leave and their score will be withdrawn from the competition.
- FaceBook aggression will not be tolerated.
- When you have finished your part in the competition, please bear in mind that scorers and officials do their best to get the score out as quickly as possible, and any offer of help from yourselves would be gratefully received, either in delivering drinks, collecting score sheets.
- The delivery of scores and the actual results will be put on line [www.ridingclubresults.co.uk](http://www.ridingclubresults.co.uk) if you have to leave the competition grounds, please arrange for your team manager to pick up your score sheets and rosettes if any.

### **FLU INJECTIONS.**

Vaccination courses started before 1 January 2024 may follow either of the intervals set out below. Intervals before 1 Jan 2024  
Intervals from 1 Jan 2024 1st Vaccination (V1)

2nd Vaccination (V2) 21-92 days 21-60 days

3rd Vaccination (V3) 150-215 days 120-180 days Booster Not more than 1 year apart Not more than 1 year apart However, any errors with first booster (which should be given either between 150 - 215 days, or 120 - 180 days after the second primary injection) or annual booster given BEFORE 1 January 2020 may be ignored provided that:

- the first two primary injections are correct i.e. the second given between 21 and 92 days after the first
- all annual boosters given AFTER 1 January 2020 are correct.

**No injection should have been given on any of the 6 days before the competition and/or entry to competition stables.**

For example: if the horse is vaccinated on the Monday, the horse will not be eligible to enter championship stables, or compete until the following Monday. Horses may compete providing that they have had the first two primary injections providing the second vaccination (V2) is not in any of the 6 preceding days of entry to the competition or competition

stabling. The vaccination section of the horse's passport, and any alterations made, must have been completed and signed/stamped by a Veterinary Surgeon. In the event of failure to comply with any of the requirements of this rule see G7.4. BRC will continue to strongly recommend a 6 month vaccination when attending BRC qualifiers and championships and maintaining good biosecurity. BRC reserve the right to amend these vaccination rules. G7.2: Equine Flu Vaccine Shortage 2022 Due to an unprecedented vaccination shortage, horses whose annual booster vaccinations fell between 1 September 2022 and 1 January 2023 the annual booster may be given up to 15 months, provided that the following vaccination is given within the following 9 months. This must be recorded in the passport and signed/stamped by a Veterinary Surgeon, or accompanied by a signed letter to that effect. Section 2 26 BRC MEMBERS HANDBOOK E.g., if your annual vaccination is due on 14 November and your vet practice are unable to vaccinate due to a shortage, you can extend the annual vaccination by up to 3 months. Annual vaccination can therefore be administered on or before 14 February, then following the guidance above must be vaccinated with an annual within 9 months. Ensure you have confirmation from the vets this is the case when attending a competition. Annual boosters due on or after 1 January 2023 must revert to the usual 12-month interval

## **Please remember not to inject your horse within 6 days of the competition.**

### **Helping at the competition**

All clubs have to help at the competitions that they enter. We do our very best to keep this to a minimum, but without this help, we could not continue. We do have a selection of volunteers who are willing to help the area, and we do call upon these, but a rota of help of clubs competing will be given out, any clubs who feel that they cannot do the task asked, please come back to Chris Rogers as soon as possible, not 2 days before the competition.

**Please look at BRC Handbook for specification of Rider and Horse eligibility. All classes, can have all juniors, all seniors or a mixture of both.**

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below: <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-rulebook>

All entrants must pay a prelim fee to British Riding Clubs at least **21 days before the date of the qualifier** (above). Entries can be made via prelim website: or forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries [www.britishridingclubs.org.uk](http://www.britishridingclubs.org.uk). Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual, if there are sufficient spaces (payable to BRC HQ). There will be a late entry fee payable to Area 2 for £10 per entry. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

#### **Hats**

All hats must have a visible aqua BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

#### **Body Protectors**

A body protector is obligatory in all cross-country competitions and is strongly recommended in show jumping competitions. A BETA Level 3 displaying either a Purple 2009 label or Blue 2018 label must be worn. Body protectors should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer's instructions. The up to date BETA list of body protectors can be obtained from [www.beta-uk.org](http://www.beta-uk.org).

Riders wearing Exo Body Cage with a 2000 purple label will be permitted. The competitor must inform the secretary at all events.

#### **Medical armbands**

Medical armbands are mandatory for any type of cross-country competition. These must be worn on the arm and not on the leg. They should be filled in with the relevant competitor's details. Checks will be carried out in the collecting ring.
