### NOTES.

- All rules relating to each discipline can be found in the 2025 British Riding Clubs Official Rule Book with the exception of any rules herein referred to.
- Closing date is 8th September 2025 and all entries must be via <a href="https://www.equusinnovation.com/brcarea22">https://www.equusinnovation.com/brcarea22</a>
- Late entries will only be accepted if space permits and will incur a late entry fee of £20 per individual. This rule will be strictly adhered to as there are a limited number of entries for the Cross Country.
- No refunds will be given after closing date
- Numbers and start times will be available to be printed from Riding Club Results
- Number Bibs should be worn for all phases on both days.
- Horses may enter more than one level of Arena Eventing as long as it is consecutive heights, i.e., 70cm & 80cm, 90cm & 100cm. Only one level of Eventing may be entered
- All dressage tests may be called .
- Whips are allowed for Eventing dressage. All whips for Arena Eventing, Show Jumping and Cross Country must be as per BRC rules
- There will be no tack steward for the dressage and show jumping classes, but tack will be visually checked for the XC.





- It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure that they and their horse have the correct tack.
- All hats must be tagged in accordance with BRC rules (Hot Pink) and for XC, back protectors must be worn.
- Sleeved tops are required, and sleeveless tops are not permitted. It is up to the individual competitor to ensure that all tack and equipment is up to standard <u>as organisers will not be held responsible for injury resulting from defective equipment or equipment not up to current standards.</u>
- Hats can be tagged onsite at the Bunkhouse
- Back Protectors must be to current standard BETA Blue 2018 Level 3
- Any objection must be lodged with a £50 deposit with the Secretary and if objection upheld, deposit will be returned.

### **STABLING**

- On site stabling booking via https://www.equusinnovation.com/brcarea22
- Cost of stabling £60/first night or only night and £30 for subsequent nights. There are ample stables on site. Please note that once stables are booked, no refund will be made as we are charged for the number of stables ordered.
- Individuals are responsible for their own stabling, should they no longer require a stable once booked, they can sell it on privately but <u>MUST</u> notify the organizer\_who is taking on the stable
- Should anyone require stabling on Thursday or Sunday night please contact the organisers
- Only straw will be provided,





- Anyone wishing to use shavings must bring their own.
- Stabling will be open from 2:30pm on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September
- Friday night stables only must be vacated by 2.00 pm and entry for Saturday night stables not available before 3.00 pm.
- A £10 deposit per stable will be required to be handed to Stable Manager on arrival; this will be returned once your stable has been checked before departure. Please put your £10 in an envelope marked with your name & horses name and a contact number.
- Please ensure you have a contact number on your stable in case of emergencies
- Flu vaccinations must be up to date as per 2025 Rule Book
- All dogs must be kept on short leads <u>at all times</u>. Extendable and retractable leads for dogs are banned from use at the venue. Owners of loose dogs will be fined the sum of £50 on the spot.
- Please ensure that all dog litter is picked up and this includes the Stable area.
- Please ensure that children are supervised at all time
- Please dispose of all litter in the bins/skip provided. Do not put broken tents/chairs etc in the skip – Take them home to dispose off
