All competitors entering the qualifier must also have a competition pass which is an annual pass that can be purchased from the Sport:80 website.

There will be a late entry fee payable to Area 2 for £10 per entry. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

Passports and Hats must be presented to the secretary for checking at each competition prior to competing.

Medical Armbands, if worn, should be on the arm and up to date

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of pre-entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry. Mixed teams can be either all junior, all senior or a mixture of both.

Entries are made through your team manager.
